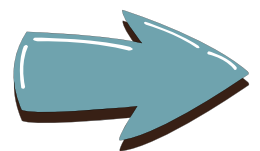

Salt Creek Highway Corridor Study

Residents of Bar Nunn and the Casper area community are invited to share feedback related to transportation needs and future safety improvements. Public comment will be available online mid-May through the project website, and the project team will host an open house event at the Bar Nunn Community Center in June. Watch for more project information coming soon and opportunities for public involvement.

Salt Creek Highway has been the backbone of Bar Nunn's transportation network, long before the town was established. Built on top of the former Wardwell Field Airport, the previous runways are now streets and most of current infrastructure is over 90 years old. Recently the Wyoming Department of Transportation (WYDOT) transferred ownership of the corridor to the Town of Bar Nunn, meaning the responsibility for addressing aging infrastructure, safety concerns, and multimodal deficiencies falls locally.

As the population of Bar Nunn continues to grow, there is a need for a plan to guide future roadway improvements along the corridor. Casper Area MPO is currently working with KLJ Engineering to conduct a corridor study along Salt Creek Highway from N Howard Street to Westwinds Road in the Town of Bar Nunn. The goal of the study is to develop a comprehensive improvement plan that aligns with the 2055 Long-Range Transportation Plan, with focus on transportation safety, traffic flow, multimodal facilities, and structural enhancements. The final corridor plan will also help to encourage development of the area, while improving safety and health of the residents of Bar Nunn and Natrona County.
