Tuesday, June 30, 2026 – 5:30 P.M.

1. **Call to Order:** Mayor, Peter Boyer called the council meeting to order Tuesday, June 30, 2026, at 5:30 p.m.

Roll Call: The roll was called which determined the presence of a quorum.

Present: Mayor, Peter Boyer. Council Members: Tim Ficken, Dan Sabrosky, and Joy Shain

2. **Pledge of Allegiance:** The Town Council and all present stood in service to the United States Flag and pledged allegiance to the United States of America.

3. **Council Vacancy Interviews**

A) Garret Wesnitzer stated he was motivated to serve his community and become involved in local government. He emphasized preserving Bar Nunn's small-town character while supporting responsible growth and maintaining community amenities such as parks and infrastructure. Mr. Wesnitzer acknowledged limited budgeting experience beyond personal finances but expressed a willingness to learn council processes, prepare thoroughly for meetings, maintain confidentiality, and faithfully uphold the constitutional responsibilities of the office.

B) Susan Burkindine stated she is pursuing a Master's of Public Administration through the University of Wyoming and viewed the appointment as an opportunity to apply her education in public service. She described extensive federal budgeting and management experience, advocated for infrastructure planning and measurable performance, and emphasized thoughtful fiscal stewardship, collaborative leadership, and transparent decision-making while maintaining the town's positive community atmosphere.

C) William Howsden stated he wished to use his background in law enforcement, emergency medical services, and volunteer organizations to serve the Town. He discussed concerns regarding public safety, consistent enforcement of town regulations, and continued development of police and fire services as Bar Nunn grows. Mr. Howsden emphasized fairness, accountability, and applying his professional experience to benefit the community.

D) Matt Boyles participated in an interview with the Council regarding his interest in serving the community, availability for meetings and events, budgeting experience, priorities for the Town, ethical responsibilities, and long-term commitment to Bar Nunn. Council members discussed future growth, fiscal responsibility, and the expectations of council service.

E) Cheryl Fisher participated in an interview with the Council regarding her qualifications, availability, community involvement, approach to decision-making, budgeting, confidentiality, and commitment to serving the residents of Bar Nunn. Council members discussed the responsibilities of elected officials and the importance of collaboration and public service.

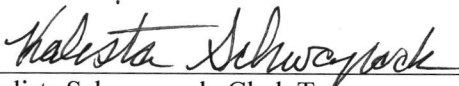
