**Electric Bicycle Regulations
(W.S.31-5-707 & 31-1-101)**

Definition: Electric bicycles must have fully operable pedals, a seat, and an electric motor of less than 750 watts (approximately 1 horsepower).

RIDER RULES:

- E-Bikes are allowed on bike paths.
- When riding on the roadway, the operator must:
 - be on the furthest right-hand edge of the road,
 - moving with traffic.
- Operators must obey all traffic signals and signs.
- When riding ½ hour before sunset to ½ hour after sunrise, the bicycle must be equipped with a:
 - headlight and
 - red rear reflector.

If your electric bicycle does not have pedals, it is considered an electric motorcycle.

Electric Motorcycles must be:

- registered,
- have lights,
- have insurance, and
- be operated by a licensed driver,
- the same as any motorcycle or ATV on the roadway.
- Riders must wear a proper motorcycle rated helmet
